Storm Drain Stenciling



What is it?

Every year, hazardous chemicals such as pesticides, paints, and used motor oil are poured into storm drains. These wastes are carried into the nearest stream, lake or wetland. A storm drain stencil is painted next to the storm drain and reads "Dump No Waste - Drains to Stream". By applying storm drain stencils you are helping to prevent this type of pollution.

How do we do it?

Girl scout troops can check out storm drain stenciling kits from the City of Bellevue. We will give you everything you need, stencils, paint, safety vests, and a map of the area you will be stenciling.

Earn a try-it, a proficiency badge, or an interest project patch!

Use storm drain stenciling as a part of these achievements. For example, storm drain stenciling can be used to earn the Eco-Action Badge.

When can we stencil?

Troops can storm drain stencil any time they want, they just need to call the City of Bellevue to set up a check-out time for storm drain stenciling kits. **ONE RULE:** The pavement **MUST BE DRY** to do storm drain stenciling, and rain can not be in the forecast for the next day. **SO, it would be best to schedule your stenciling in September or early October.**
